IN A LANDSCAPE: Classical Music in the Wild™ is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit outdoor concert series created by American pianist Hunter Noack.

A nine-foot concert grand Steinway piano is set in awe-inspiring natural landscapes including parks, ranches, botanical gardens, and farms instead of the traditional concert hall. The audience is encouraged to wander and explore the surrounding environment while listening to the music through wireless headphones.

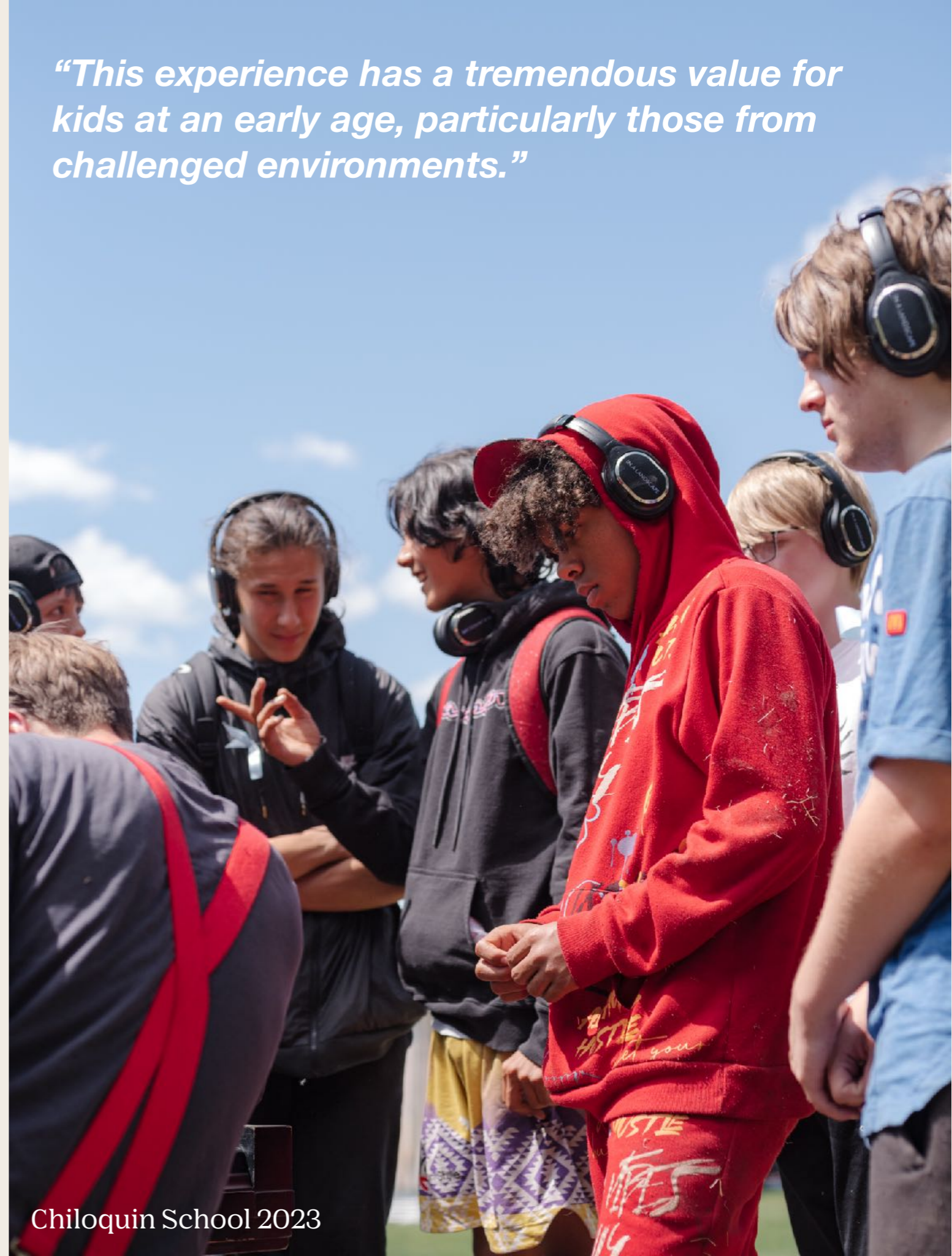


LOCAL IMPACT

IN A LANDSCAPE engages with every host community. We subsidize ticket pricing at 95% of our concerts, provide free tickets to locals directly and through partner organizations, and grant money through our benefit program to school music classes, tribal initiatives, rural fire departments, land trusts, and other non-profit community groups.

In addition to public concerts we present free concerts for schools either on campus or through field trips to concert locations in the wild.

FOUNDER'S STORY

American pianist Hunter Noack grew up hunting, fishing, and kayaking the rivers of Oregon and studied music at Interlochen Arts Academy, the San Francisco Conservatory, University of Southern California in Los Angeles, and Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London. He moved back to Oregon in 2016 and started IN A LANDSCAPE to combine his love for classical music and the great outdoors.

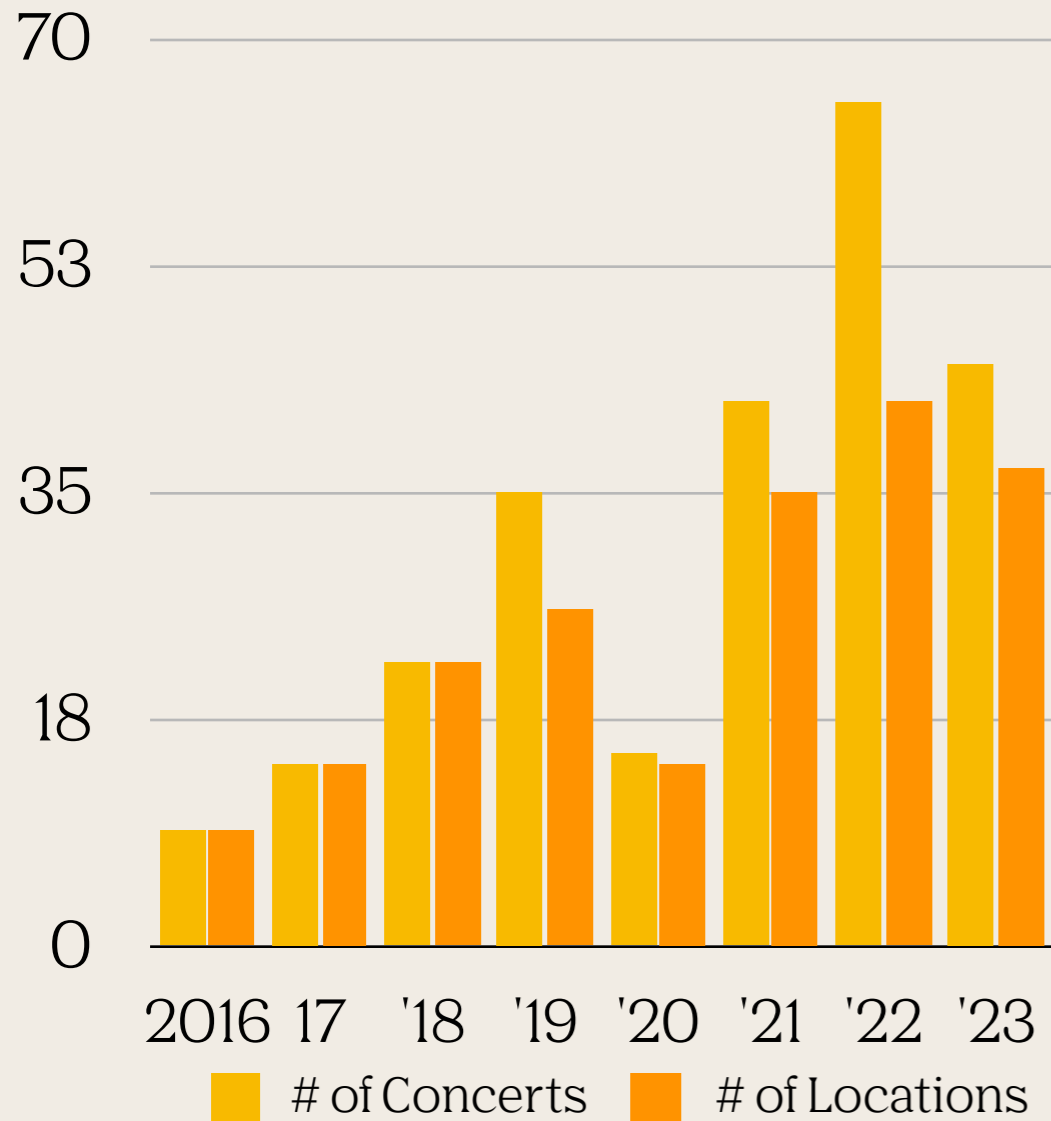
As Artistic Director, Hunter prioritizes collaborations with artists not typically associated with traditional western classical music: from visual and culinary artists, to dancers, poets, and singers.

This has led to friendships and collaborations with artists like James Edmund Greeley, an award-winning Native American flutist on Warm Springs Reservation; NoNoBoy, who sang original songs about erased Asian-American history in the American West and his own Vietnamese heritage at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial of Oregon, cowboy-poet Elizabeth Davis, who demonstrated how to use a stock whip after reading a poem about her father in the Alvord Desert, and May Arden, a singer who performed opera, folk, and original songs in the historic dredge and led a sing-a-long for everyone on the steam-engine train ride back from the concert in the old mining town of Sumpter, Oregon.

Sharing the work of these performing artists alongside stories about the music, local history, and culture (often from locals themselves) bonds fellow concert goers to each other and the surrounding landscape.

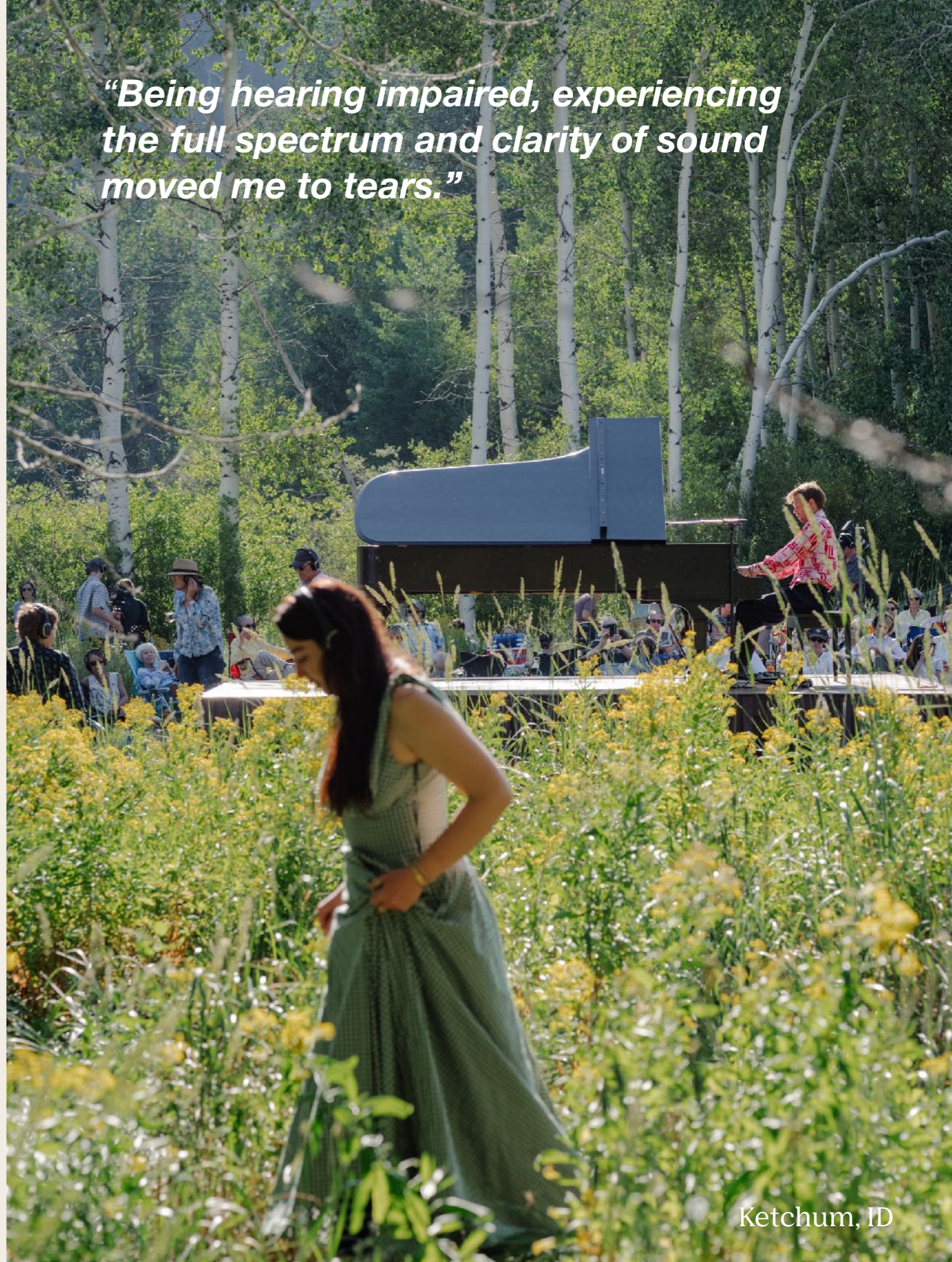
PROGRAM GROWTH

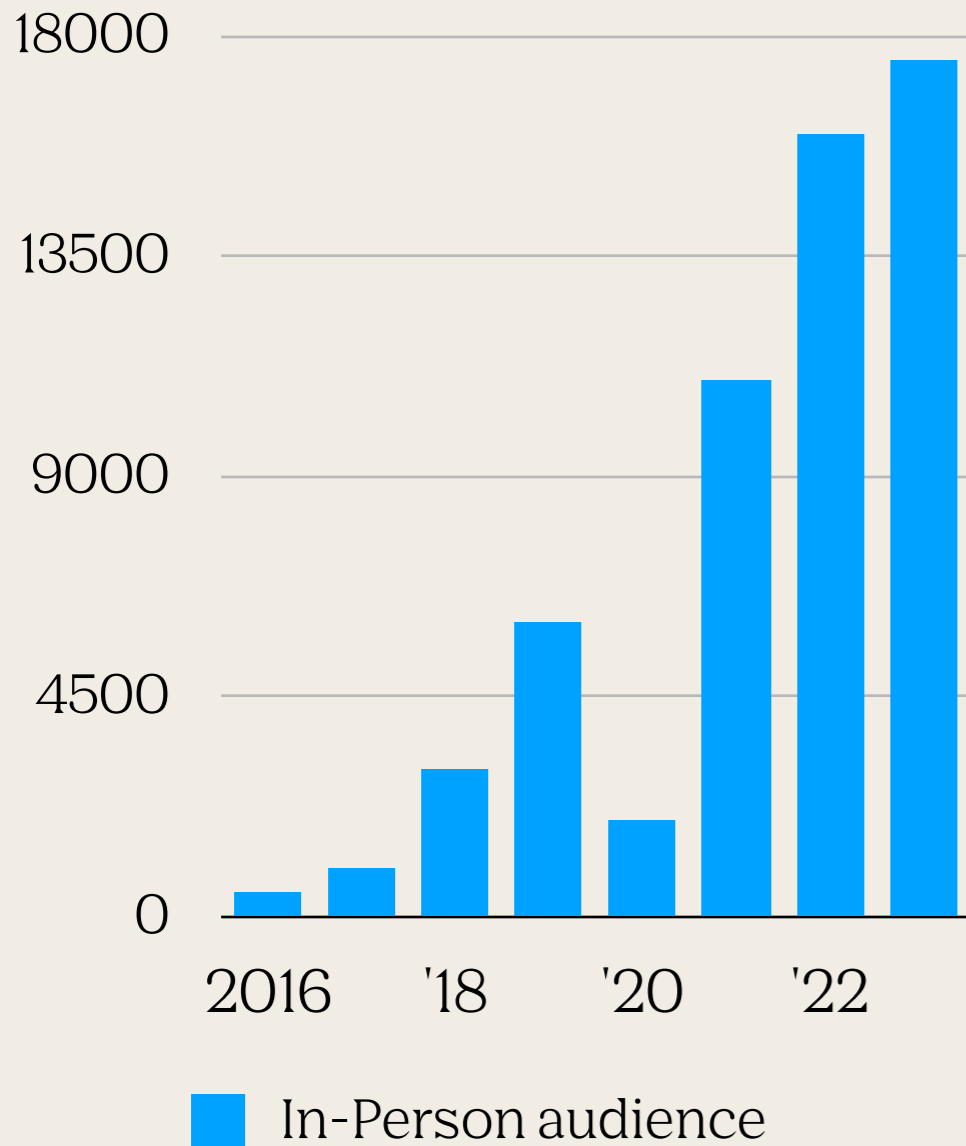

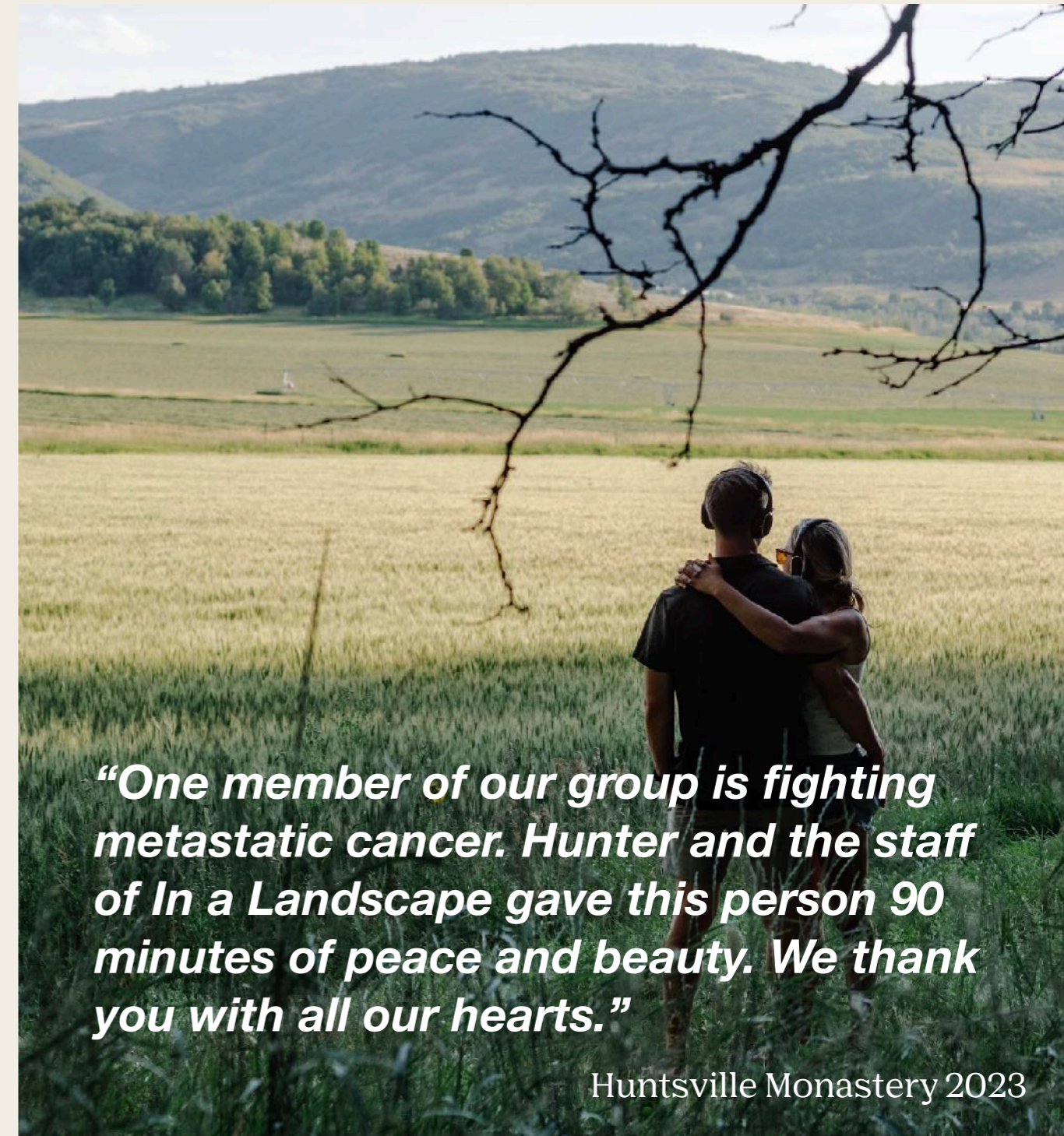
GIVING BACK

In 2023 we brought our 9' Steinway piano to Bybee Lakes Hope Center, one of Portland's largest homeless shelters, schools in Chiloquin and Warm Springs, Oregon, the Alvord Desert, more than 250 miles from the nearest concert hall, Warm Springs Indian Reservation, and dozens of other unique concert settings. We subsidize ticket costs for 95% of concerts, and annually provide \$100,000+ in free tickets through our Good Neighbor Program.

2023 GRANTEES

We run a series of benefit concerts in which we pass on a portion of ticket sales in the form of grants to our community partners. In 2023, we awarded \$115,700.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS

- Over 6,000 experienced live classical music for the first time,
- We presented our largest concerts yet, at the Portland Rose Garden Amphitheater in Washington Park, selling out both nights with 1,000 people each night,
- The First Annual Pie Social at Fort Rock Grange Hall happened after the concert in the nearby state historic site,
- IN A LANDSCAPE was featured on PBS show, “America Outdoors with Baratunde Thurston,” and
- Our first stargazing concert celebrated Oregon’s first officially designated Dark Sky state park at Prineville Reservoir State Park.

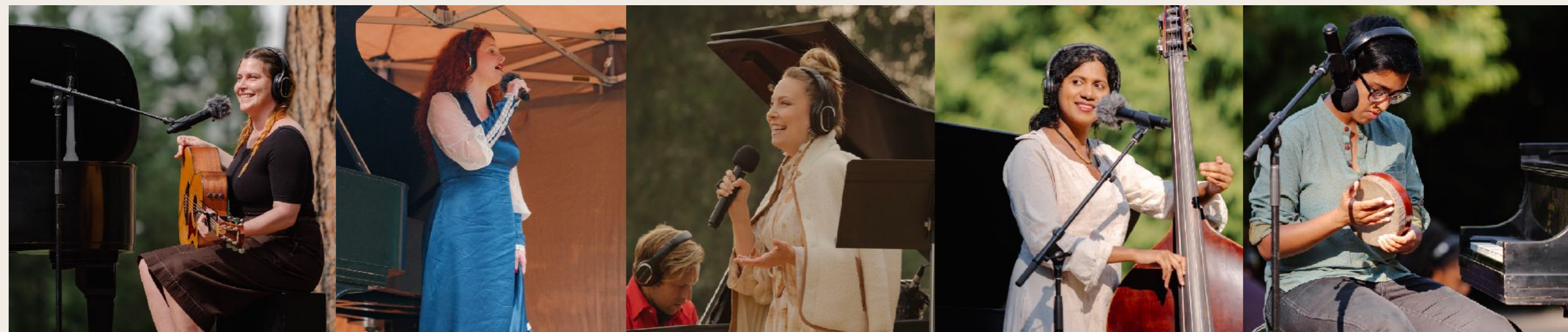

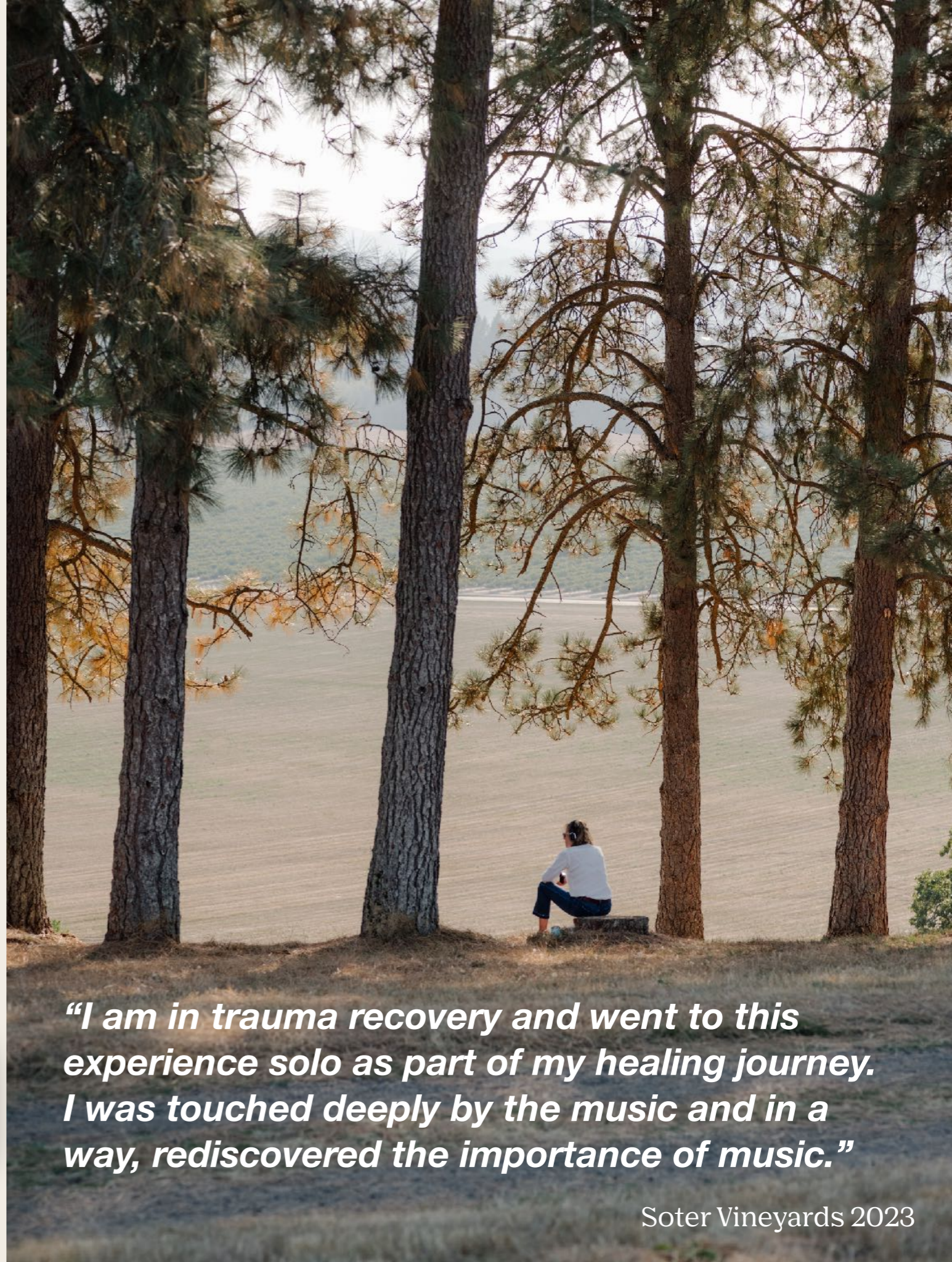
